## Do I need to bring a tent/canopy?

Maker Faire Louisville will provide a minimum 10' x 10' exhibition space under a tent. Powered booth areas (120V) are available if needed. Please bring personal seating.

## Do I need to be present Saturday and Sunday?

In order for Maker Faire Louisville to be a success, we need exhibits to be available to the public for both days. If you have a conflict, please contact us.

## When is load-in and load out?

Friday September 27th is load in for makers who need more than two hours of setup time. Otherwise, load-in begins at 8AM on Saturday morning.

## Can I leave my exhibit throughout the weekend?

Maker Faire Louisville will have uniformed security officers on site beginning on Friday until Monday morning.

## Will food be provided?

There will be food trucks / local dining options located on site to accommodate most dietary needs throughout the weekend.

## Will you have RV parking/hook-ups?

Maker Faire Louisville will not host RVs on-site, but exhibitors and attendees are welcome to find local accomodation for RVs.

## Will pets be allowed?

No pets are allowed at Maker Faire Louisville. Exceptions include certified service/support animals only.

## What if it rains?

Maker Faire will occur on September 28th and 29th, rain or shine.

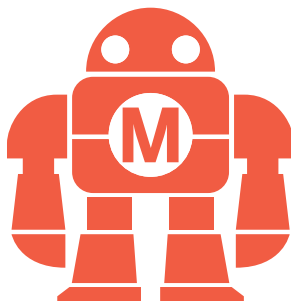
